The Teacher Education Add-on Program for Certification in the Gifted Endorsement is designed to provide teachers local access to professional learning and to address Florida's critical teacher shortages in programs for ESE. The target audience are teachers assigned out-of-field in gifted programs; however, the modules are appropriate for certification renewal and /or professional learning. Priority will be given to teachers who are currently teaching gifted students. Enrollment is limited to 25 participants. Credits earned through this program may not be used for college or university credit. It will be the responsibility of the participant to verify with their local staff development office and/or the Florida Department of Education certification office any additional certification requirements.
